Prep School Girls' Clothing List

This is a list of clothing and equipment required by Prep Girls at Fettes College. The majority of items are available from the Fettes College Shop; full contact details are below. Fettes College staff manage the School Shop; we supply Fettes school uniform, sportswear and sports equipment, stationery, academic books and other essentials to life at Fettes. Please note that the starred items (*) are not available in the school shop and need to be purchased elsewhere.

The shop is open during term time Monday to Friday from 8am – 3pm, and Saturdays from 9.30am – 12.30pm. Full details of holiday opening hours are sent out prior to the summer.

The shop accepts all major credit and debit cards. We are very happy to manage orders by phone or e-mail. It is recommended that new pupils try on their clothes to ensure that they have the correct size.

During term time pupils and parents can purchase items from the shop and charge them to the school bill, you will then receive a detailed invoice at the end of term attached to the main school bill. Please call or email the shop ahead of pupil visit to authorise purchase.

Appointment System

Uniform fittings last approximately one hour therefore it is essential during term time and in the summer holidays to make an appointment in advance to ensure we have adequate staff in the shop.

The Thrift Shop, which sells second-hand items, is part of the main school shop.

Naming Clothing

All items must be clearly named before arriving at school.

Woven nametapes, which are sewn on, tend to last better. We also recommend that all shoes be clearly named (you can use self-adhesive shoe labels or a permanent marker).

It is the responsibility of parents and guardians to ensure that all clothing and equipment is fully named.

The school shop has the facility to label uniform in the school shop and the cost is 75p per item. Please ensure that you let us know if you would like this service at the time of booking your uniform appointment. All uniform must be tried on and paid for before it is labelled.

Day Wear

- 2 Fettes tartan pleated skirts
- 10 White long-sleeved blouses with revere collars
- 10 Pairs of thick dark navy tights or knee length navy socks (summer)

Outer Wear

- 1 Fettes College Prep School Coat
- 1 Fettes tartan lambswool scarf (optional)
- 1 Fettes College bobble hat (optional)
- 1 Pair of navy gloves (optional) *

- 1 Pair of strong, low-heeled, polishable black shoes, lace up or Velcro (no ballet style pumps, kitten heels or high heels) *
- 1 Rucksack/schoolbag for books and files *
- 1 Pencil case fully stocked with named items (HB pencils, rubber, sharpener, colouring pencils, 30cm ruler, protractor, circle drawing implement, glue and scissors. A blue handwriting or fountain pen is needed for S form and above)
- 1 Named water bottle

General Items

- 3 Nightdresses or pyjamas *
- 1 Dressing gown *
- 1 Pair of slippers *
- 5 Bras (if required) *
- 14 Pairs of pants *
- 1 Sponge bag (shower gel, toothbrush, hairbrush, shampoo etc, no aerosols at all please – all items named) *
- 2 Bath towels *
- Bed linen - Iona House provides all bed linen. You may provide your own bed linen if preferred. *

Informal Wear for Weekends

- 3 Casual outfits *
- 1 swimsuit (optional) *
- 1 Warm and waterproof jacket *
- 1 Pair of waterproof trousers (optional) *
- 1 Pair of strong walking boots/shoes or wellington boots (optional) *

Equipment

- 30 Spare nametapes (iron on or sticker) *
- 1 Large laundry bag
- 1 Small laundry bag
- 8 Coat hangers (optional) *
- 1 Small rucksack for expeditions *
- 1 coded padlock (optional) *

Notes

1. Everything must be clearly named.
2. Please do not bring more clothing than is listed, especially weekend wear, as storage is limited.
3. Whilst in uniform, hair must be tied back off the face, hair bands and scrunchies should be plain black, navy or Fettes tartan.
4. Suitcases are preferable to trunks for moving and storing.
5. Tuck – no nuts or chewing gum.
