Senior Clothing List

This is a list of clothing and equipment required by Senior students boarding at Fettes College. We will recommend the quantity required for day students during their appointment in the shop.

The majority of items are available from the Fettes College Shop, contact details are below. Fettes College staff manage the School Shop – we supply Fettes school uniform, sportswear and some sports equipment, stationery, academic books and other essentials for life at Fettes. Please note that the starred items (*) are not available in the school shop and need to be purchased elsewhere.

The shop is open during term time Monday to Friday from 8am – 3pm, and Saturdays from 9.30am – 12.30pm. Full details of holiday opening hours are emailed to parents prior to the summer break.

The shop accepts all major credit and debit cards. We are happy to manage orders by phone or e-mail, but we do recommend that new students try on their clothes to ensure that they are the correct size.

During term time students and parents can purchase items from the shop and charge them to the school bill, you will then receive a detailed invoice at the end of each term, along with the main school bill.

Appointment System

Uniform fittings last approximately one hour therefore it is essential during term time and in the summer holidays to make an appointment in advance to ensure we have adequate staff in the shop.

The Thrift Shop

This is a dedicated area within the main school shop which sells second-hand items.

Naming Clothing

All items must be clearly named before arriving at school, and labels must contain the pupil's name with the appropriate House letters:

AR Arniston / CE College East / CW College West / DA Dalmeny
CA Carrington / GL Glencorse / KI Kimmerghame / MO Moredun

Woven nametapes, which are sewn on, tend to last better. We also recommend that all shoes are clearly named (you can use self-adhesive shoe labels or a permanent marker).

It is the responsibility of parents and guardians to ensure that all clothing and equipment is fully named.

The school shop has the facility to label uniform and the cost is 75p per item. Please ensure that you let us know if you would like this service at the time of booking your uniform appointment. All uniform must be tried on and paid for before it is labelled.

Either of these options are acceptable for Day Wear

Day Wear – Striped Blazer

1 School striped blazer

3 Pairs of charcoal grey trousers/2 Charcoal grey kilted skirts (kilts must fit neatly at the waist and be knee length)

6 White long-sleeved shirts – no button-down collars /6 White long sleeved revere collar blouses

1 Dark navy V-neck jumper

1 House tie/1 House badge

Sixth Form option- alternative “professional” style shirts for day wear.



Day Wear – Navy Blazer

- 1 School navy blazer
- 2 Fettes tartan kilts (kilts must fit neatly at the waist and be knee length)
- 6 White long-sleeved school blouses with rever collars
- 1 Dark navy V-neck jumper
- 1 House badge



Formal Wear

The Middle School wear school uniform and if wearing a white shirt, a Fettes College school striped tie should be worn instead of the usual house tie.

In Sixth Form, Chapel wear should be smart business wear: a formal suit, trouser suit, dress or dress and jacket. Skirts, if worn, should be knee length or longer and shoes should be of a suitable height. *

Outdoor Wear

- 1 Smart, plain navy/black dark jacket/coat *
- 1 Fettes tartan wool scarf (optional)
- 1 Fettes College striped wool scarf (optional)

General items

- 1 Pair of sturdy, polishable black leather shoes (flimsy shoes and shoes with high or kitten heels are not acceptable) *
- 6 Pairs of dark grey/black socks or black opaque tights
- 1 Rucksack or bag for books and files *
- 1 Pair of warm trousers – for Field Trips *
- 1 Gagoule or waterproof anorak – for weekend camps etc. *
- 1 Pair of walking boots (optional) *

Sportswear

- 1 Named bag to contain all sports equipment *
- 1 Towel *
- 1 Pair of Fettes tracksuit trousers
- 1 Fettes tracksuit jacket
- 1 Fettes hoodie
- 2 Fettes sports top
- 1 Fettes base layer top
- 1 Fettes PE shorts/Fettes skort
- 1 Fettes base layer leggings - optional
- 2 Pairs of Fettes games socks
- 2 Pairs of white sports socks
- 1 House top - optional
- 1 Pair of House socks
- 1 Navy swimming costume/trunks
- 1 Swimming cap (for shoulder length hair and longer) – optional
- 1 Pair of non-marking indoor trainers *



The additional uniform/equipment listed below for rugby/hockey/lacrosse/tennis is only required for students in 3rd and 4th form and if they choose to play these sports in 5th form, Lower 6 and Upper 6.

Rugby – autumn term for boys

- 2 Fettes reversible rugby shirt
- 2 Pairs of Fettes navy rugby shorts
- 1 Pair of base layer shorts
- 1 Pair of rugby/football boots *
- 1 Mouth guard



Hockey – autumn term for girls and spring term for boys

- 1 Hockey stick *
- 1 Pair of shin guards
- 1 Pair of AstroTurf trainers *
- 1 Mouth guard

Lacrosse – spring term for girls

- 1 Lacrosse stick *
- 1 Lacrosse goggles
- 1 Lacrosse gloves (optional)
- 1 Pair of football boots *
- 1 Mouth guard

Tennis – summer term

- 1 Tennis racket *
- 1 Fettes sports top

Cricket – summer term (for teams only) – All other players wear sports top and tracksuit bottoms.

- 1 Cricket shirt
- 1 Cricket trousers
- 1 Abdo guard
- 1 Cricket slipover or jumper – optional
